



Local Law 93 of 2015 (Previously Local Law 6 of 2011) – Biannual Report

Suspensions

Pursuant to Local Law 93 of 2015, the Department of Education is required to provide reports on student discipline data (suspension data) to the City Council twice a year (October 31 and March 31). The October reporting requires citywide suspension data by month for the second half of the academic year, January through June. Per the legislation and in accordance with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), any value from zero (0) to five (5) has been redacted.

The following analyses include six month and year-over-year suspension data comparisons between SY2022-2023 and SY2021-2022.

Data from January 2023 – June 2023, when compared to the same time period in SY2021-2022 (January 2022 – June 2022), shows an increase of 6.2% in total suspensions. Principal suspensions increased by 6.2% and superintendent suspensions increased by 5.9%.

When comparing the full school years (July 2022 to June 2023 and July 2021 to June 2022), total suspensions increased by 13.1% with principal suspensions increasing by 13.8% and superintendent suspensions increasing by 10.7%.

EMS Transports

In addition, pursuant to Local Law 93 of 2015, the Department of Education is required to provide the total number of EMS transports and the number of EMS transports performed because of a student's psychological/emotional condition to City Council twice a year (October 31 and March 31). The October reporting requires EMS data disaggregated by district and by month for the second half of the school year (January to June). Per the legislation and in accordance with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), any value from zero (0) to five (5) has been redacted.
