

2023-24 School Closure Discharge Reporting

In June 2024, one New York City public school closed. This report provides data regarding students enrolled in this school during the 2023-24 school year, according to the guidelines set by Local Law 2011/043.¹ Counts of 0 to 9 were suppressed throughout the report. In some cases, higher counts were suppressed if that information would result in the ability to determine the values of suppressed counts through subtraction.

Given that only one school was closed in 2023-24, only the school-level spreadsheet is posted and not the aggregates by city, borough and district.

Middle Schools

One New York City public middle schools/K-8 stopped serving students after June 2024:

- 12X098 Herman Ridder JHS

There were 113 students enrolled in this middle school during the 2023-24 school year. Of these students:

- 110 students (97%) were promoted to high school or transferred to another NYCPS school, charter school or homeschooling
- 3 (3%) students were discharged to a school outside NYC
- 21 students (19%) were students with disabilities in 2023-24
- Rates of attendance during the 2023-24 school year:
 - 95 (84%) students had an attendance rate between 81-100%,
 - 14 (12%) students had an attendance rate between 61-80%,
 - 0 to 9 students had an attendance rate between 41-60%,
 - 0 to 9 students had an attendance rate between 0-40%.
