







# After Remaining Flat for Years, NYC's Graduation Rate Steadily Increased







If more students place out of ELL status, the profile of the students in the ELL category shifts, impacting the graduation rate. The cohort for the Class of 2020 was 7,429, Class of 2021 was 8,376, the Class of 2022 was 9,760 and the Class of 2023 was 7,968.

4-Year Rate w/ August






