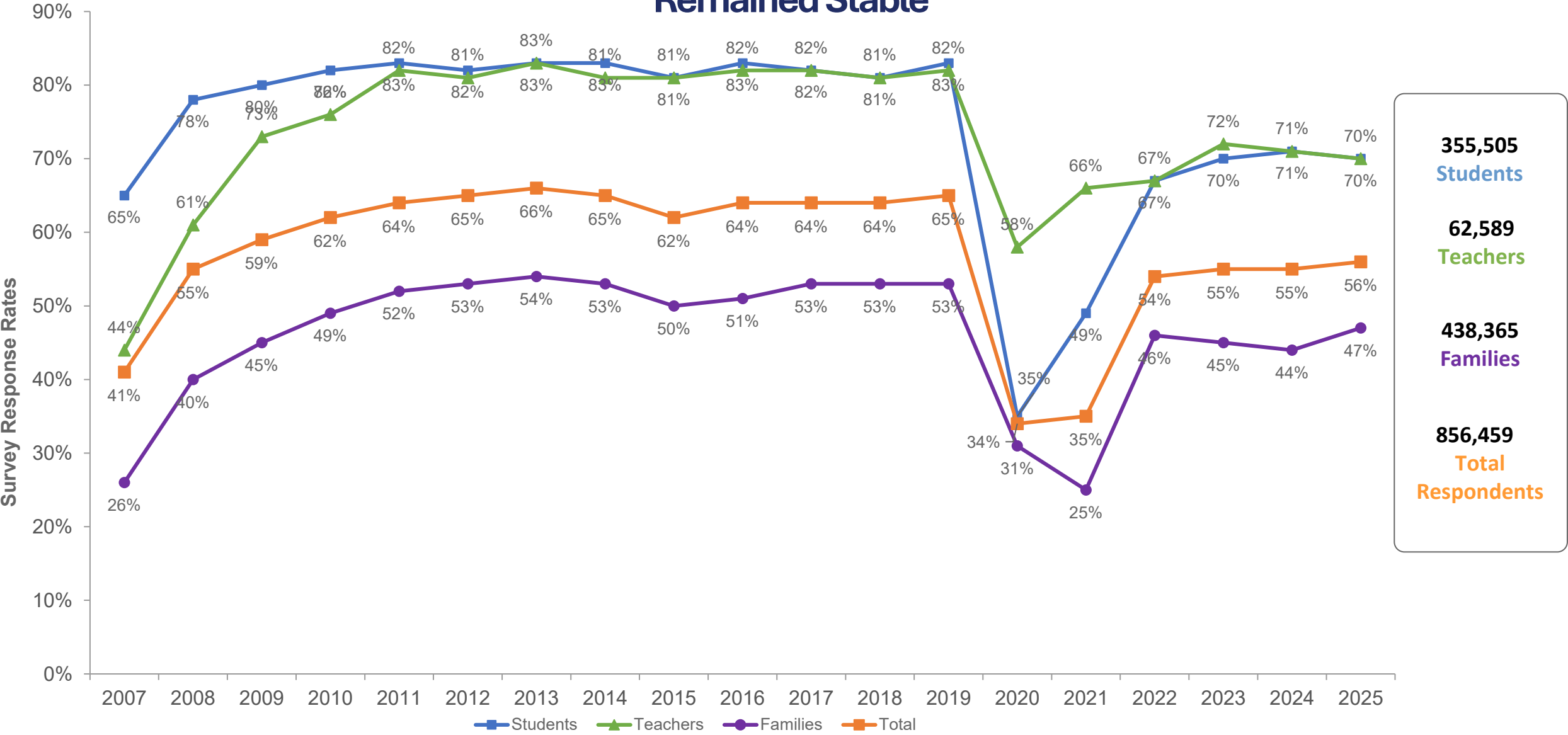

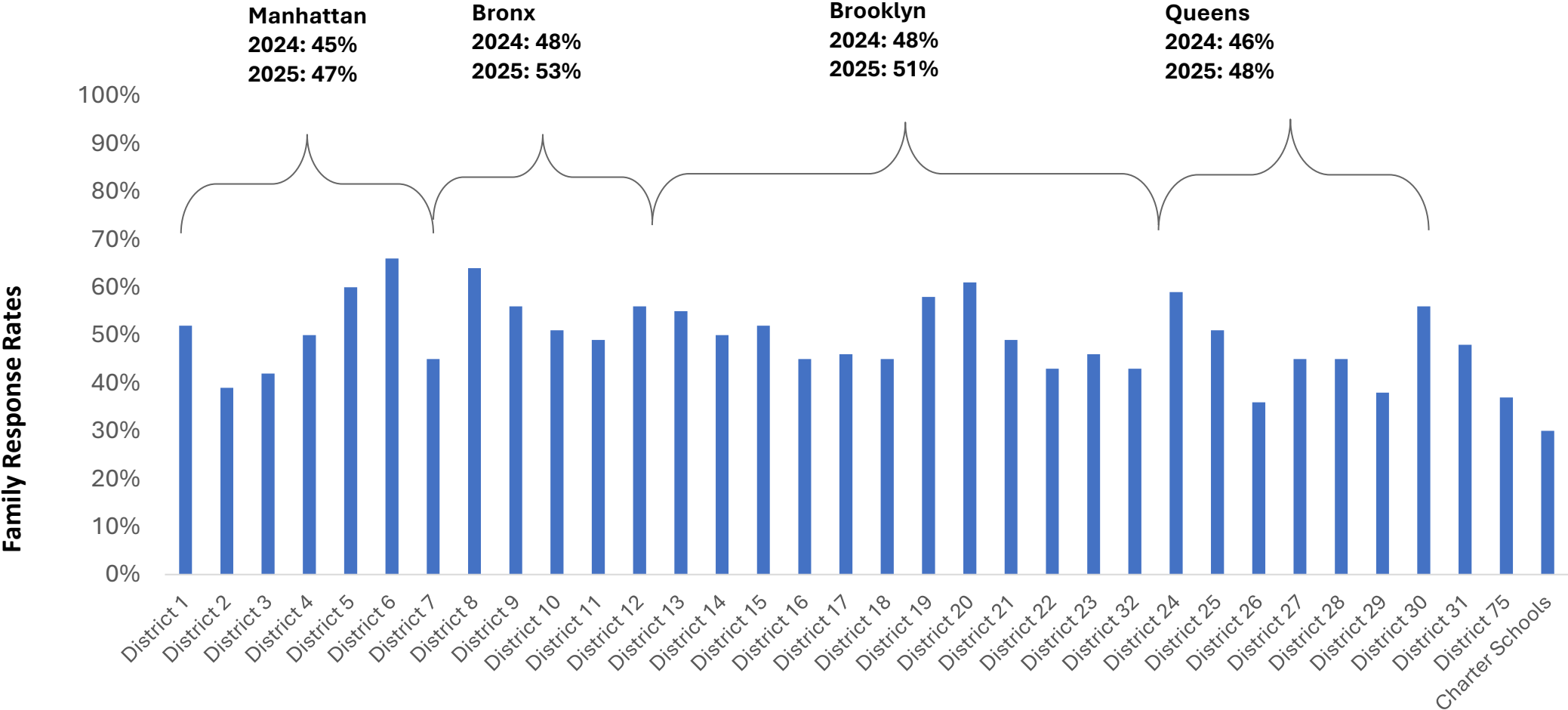

# Family Response Rates Increased for the First Time Since 2022 While Student and Teacher Rates Remained Stable

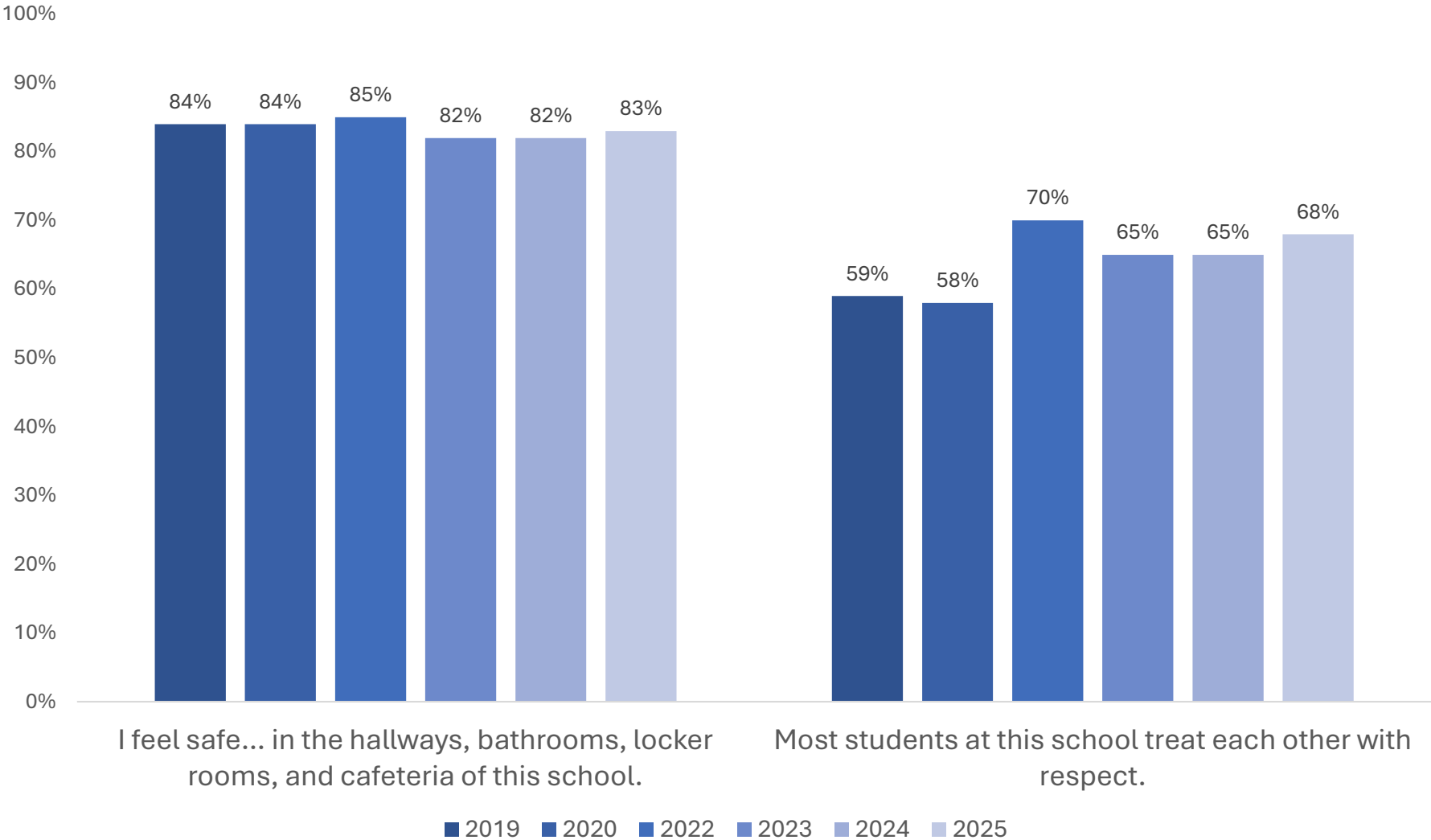


# 2025 Family Survey Participation Citywide



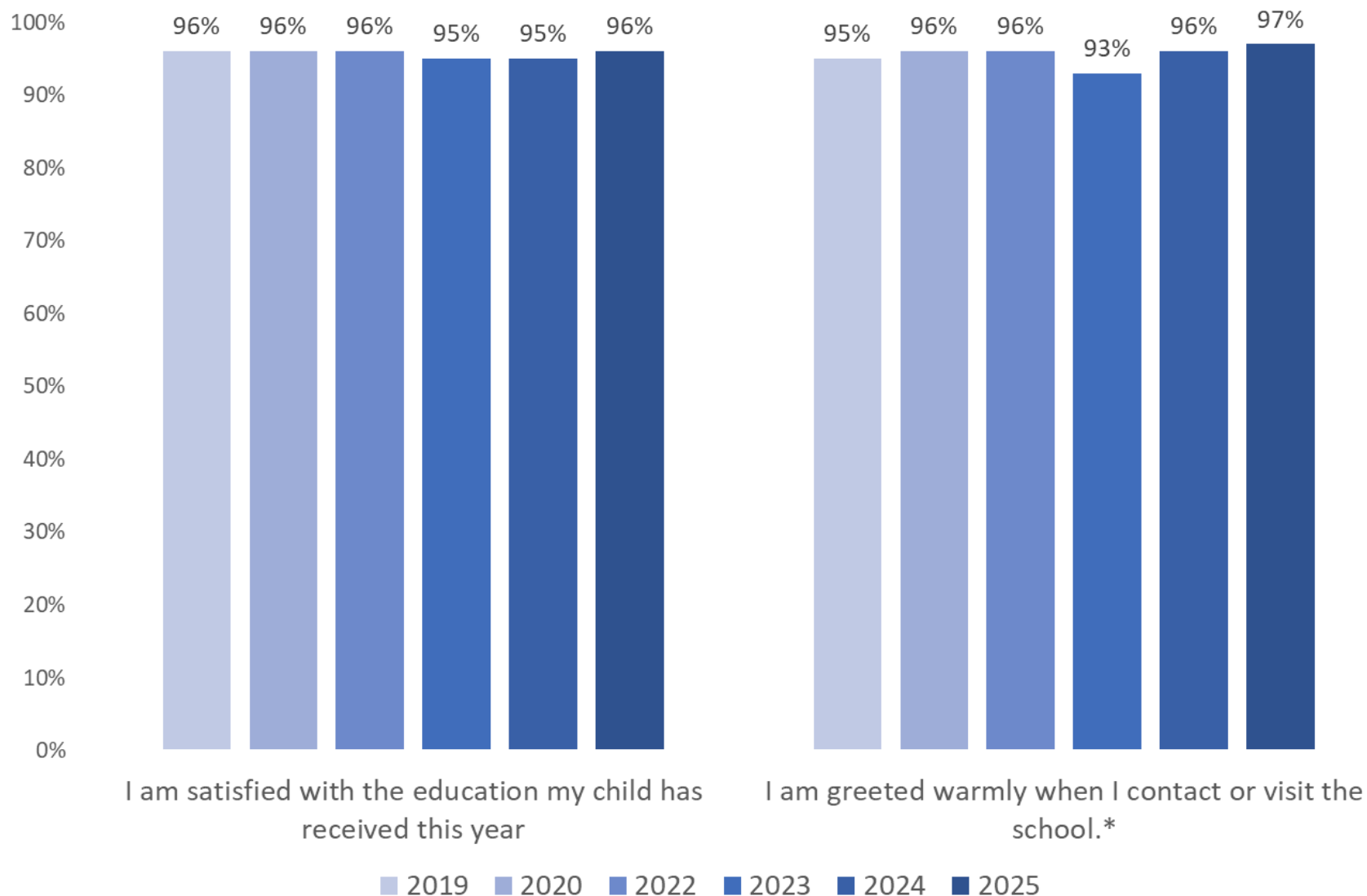

# Student Perspective on Safety and Respect

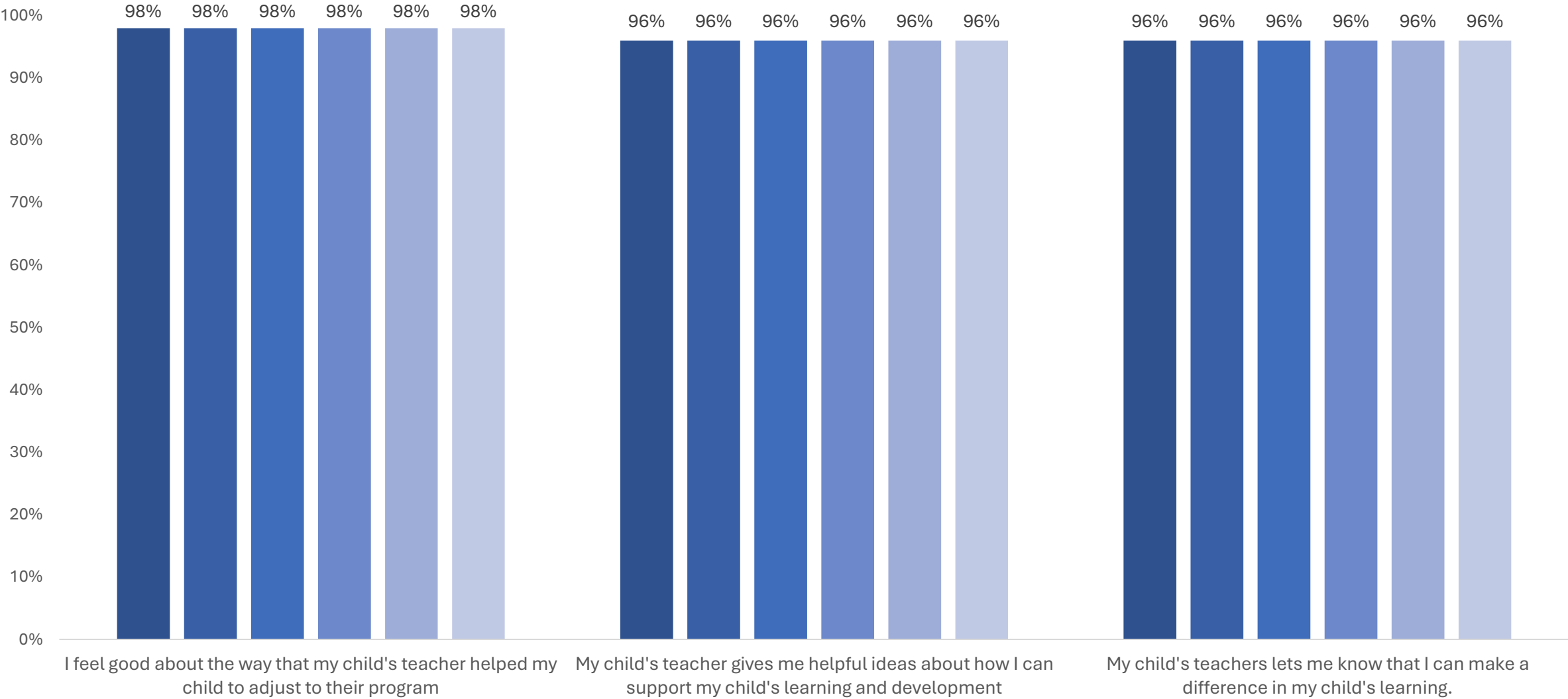

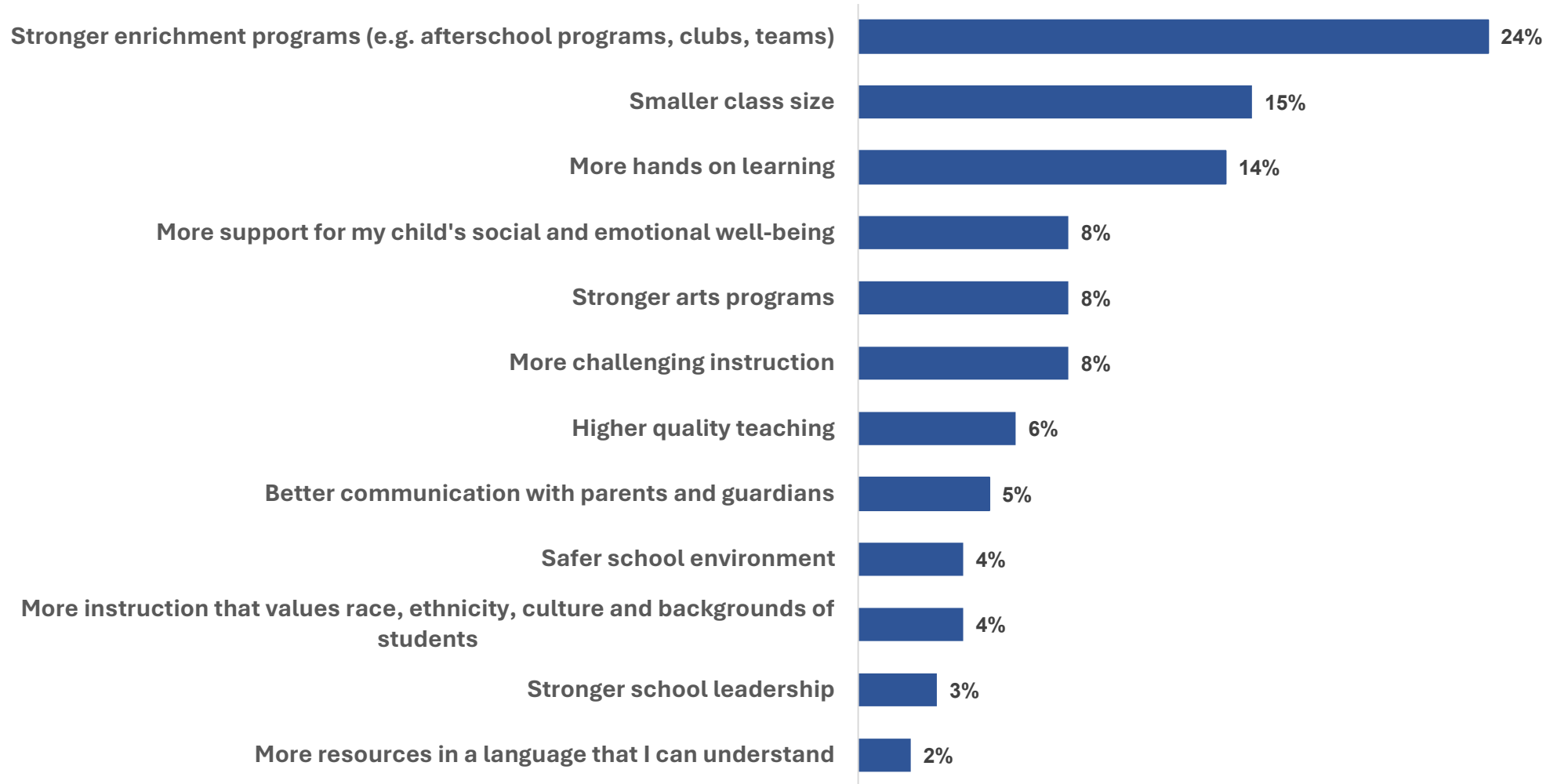
# School Families' Satisfaction Over Time Remains Consistent and Generally High



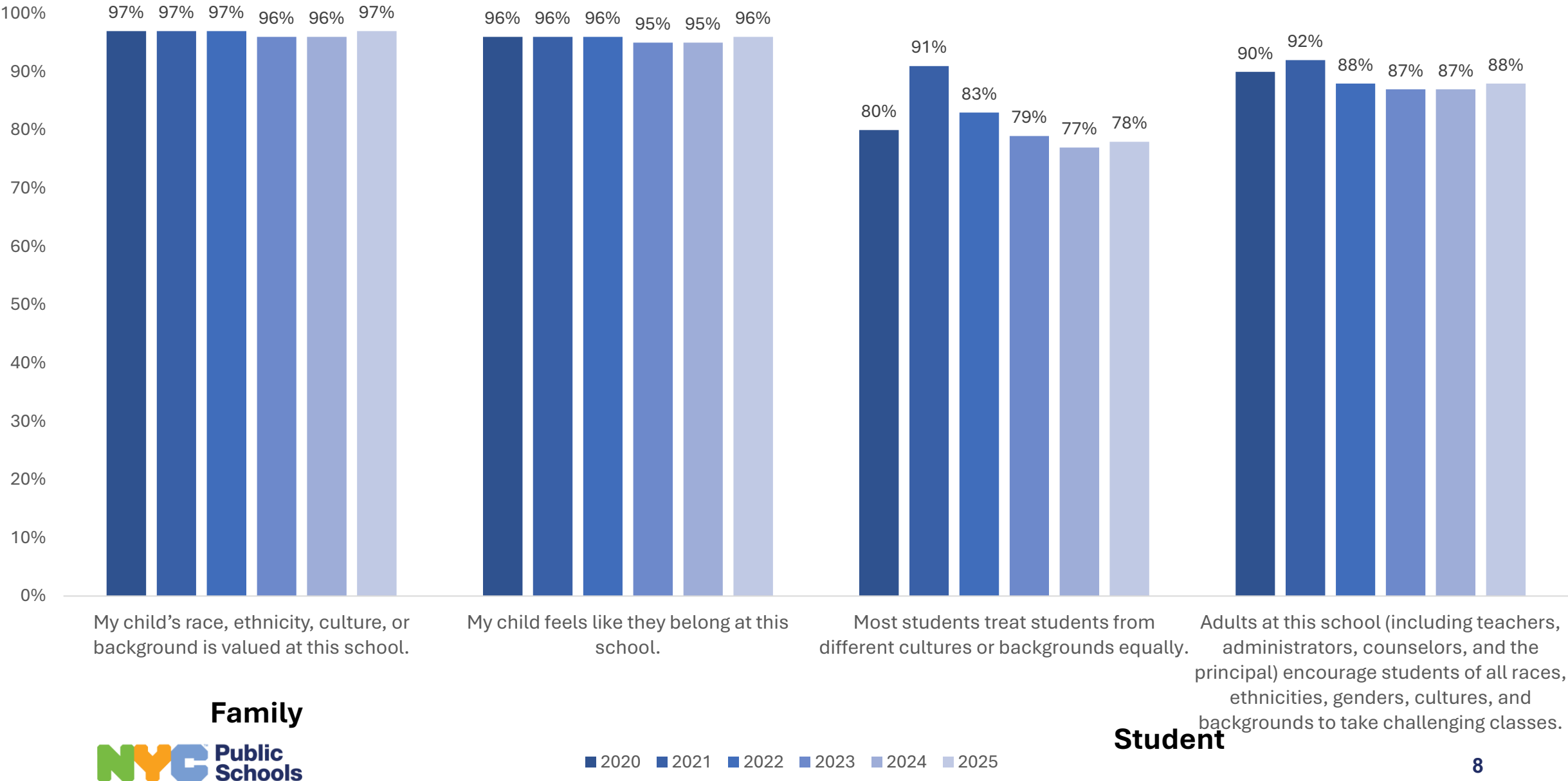
# Families of Children in Birth to 5 Programs Report that They Continue to Feel Supported by Their Programs



# Like Previous Years, Families Identify "Stronger Enrichment Programs" as the Most Requested School Improvement

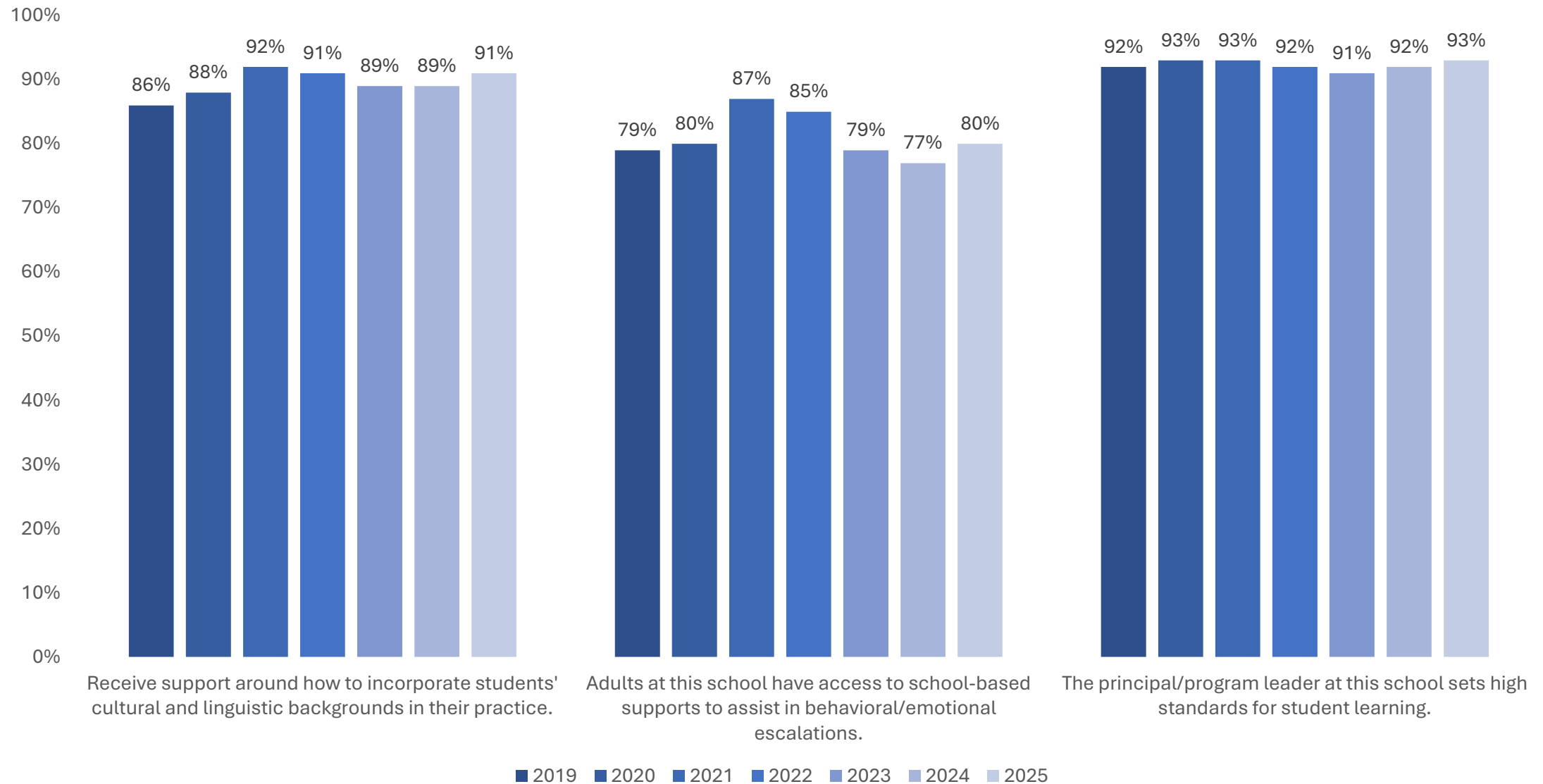

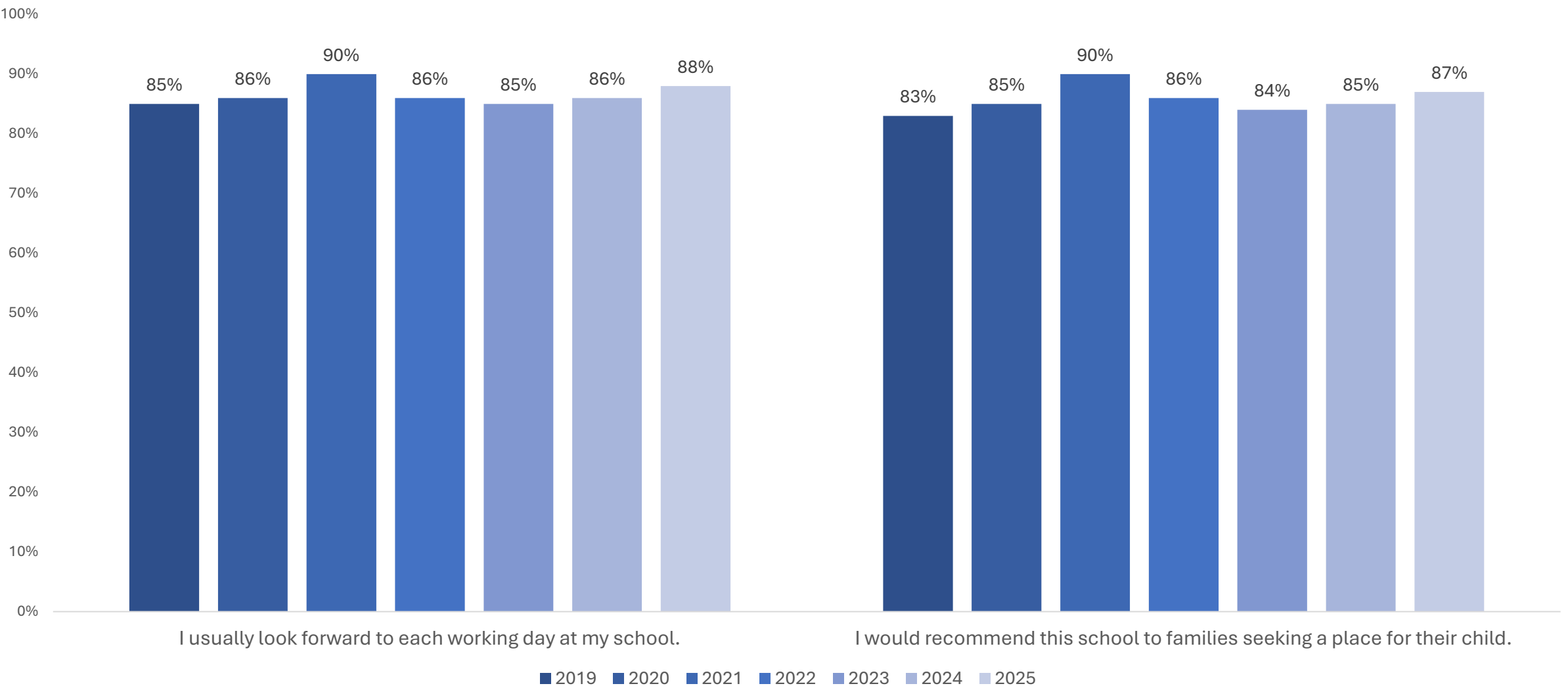




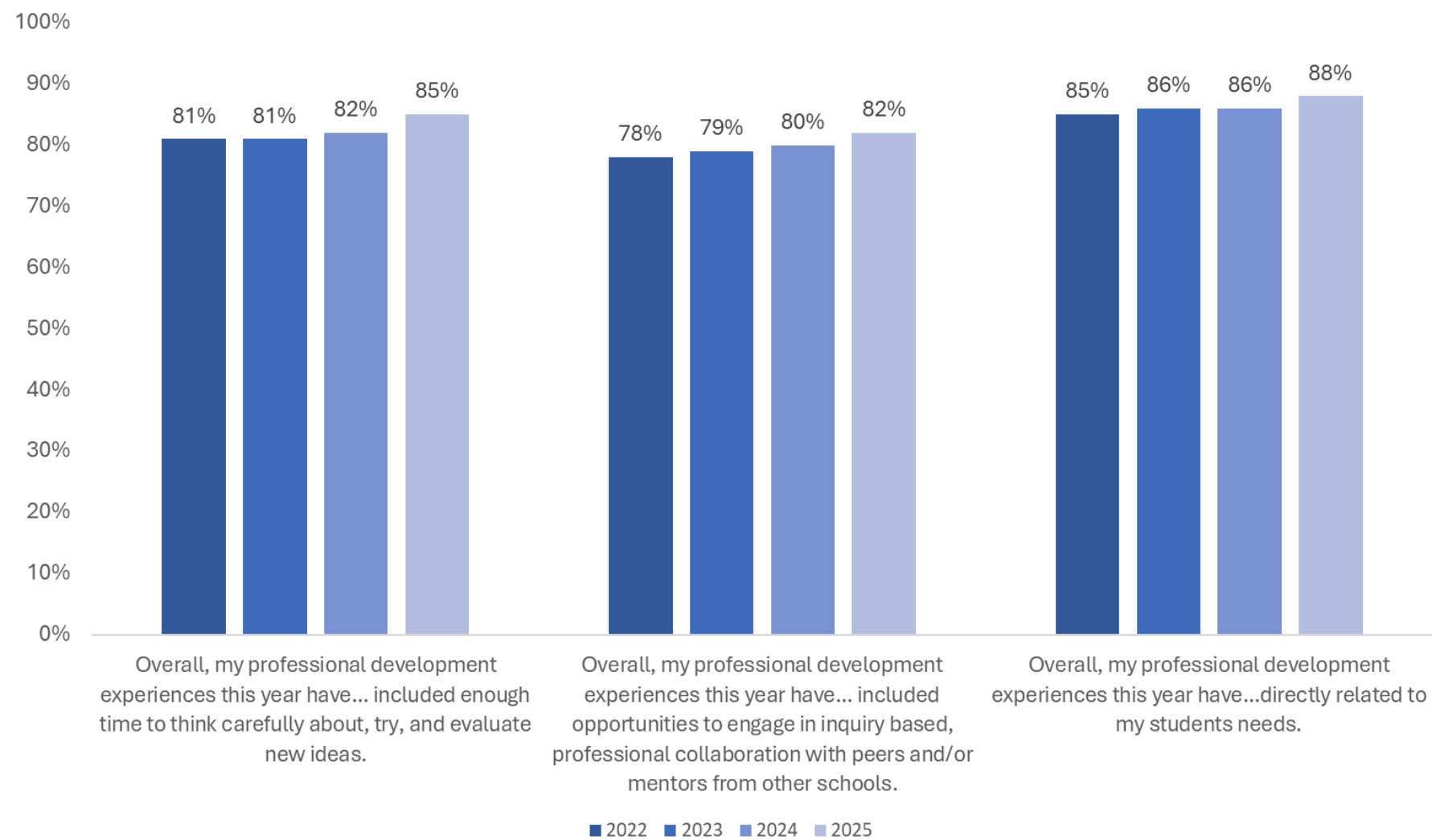
# Teachers' Perspective on Learning Environment in their Schools



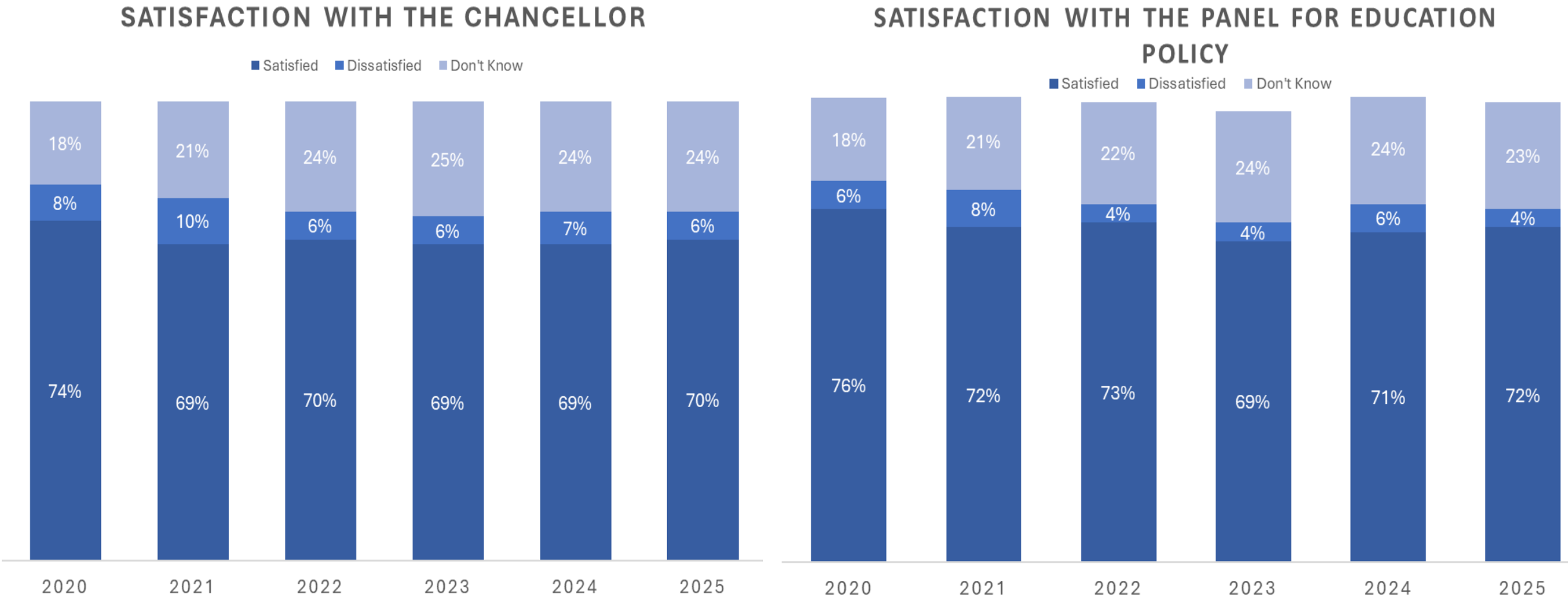
# Teachers' Reported Similar Satisfaction Over Time and Willingness to Recommend Their School to Families



# Teachers' Reported Similar Satisfaction with the Quality of Their Professional Development Experiences this Year



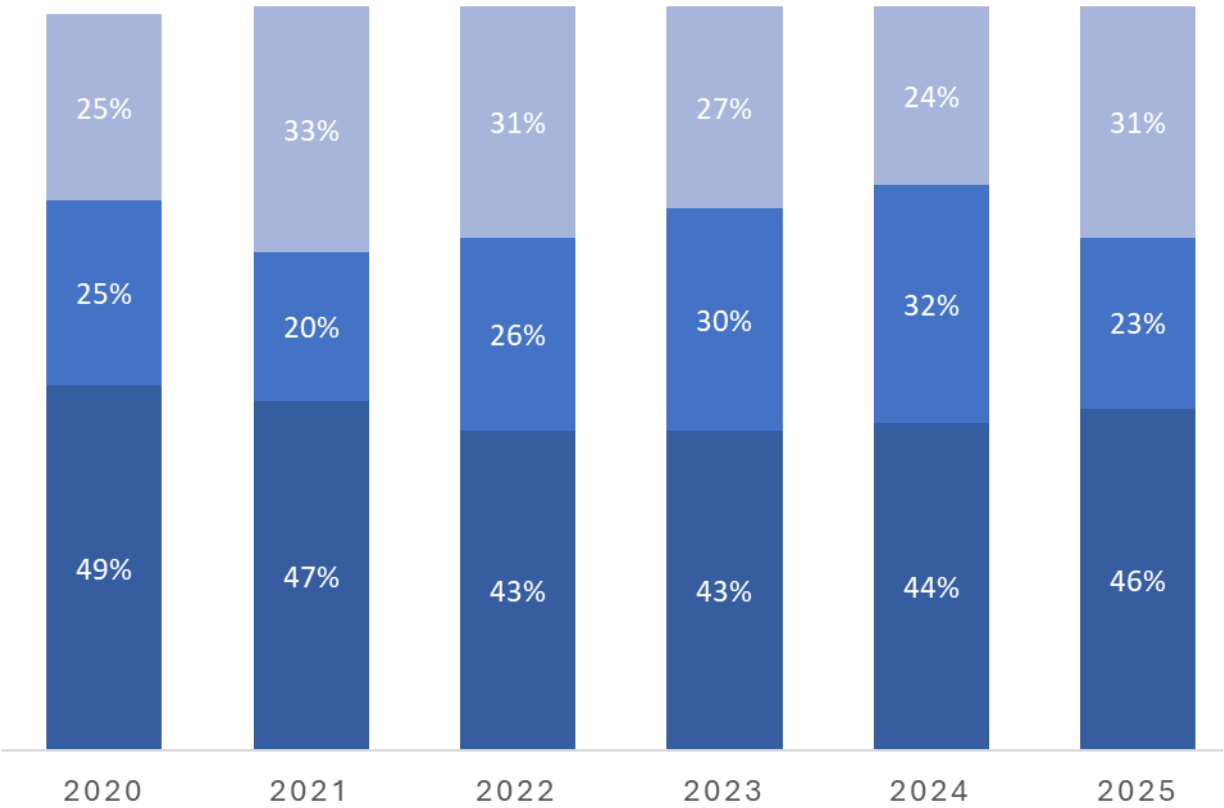
# Families Report Similar Satisfaction with the Schools Chancellor and the Panel for Education Policy

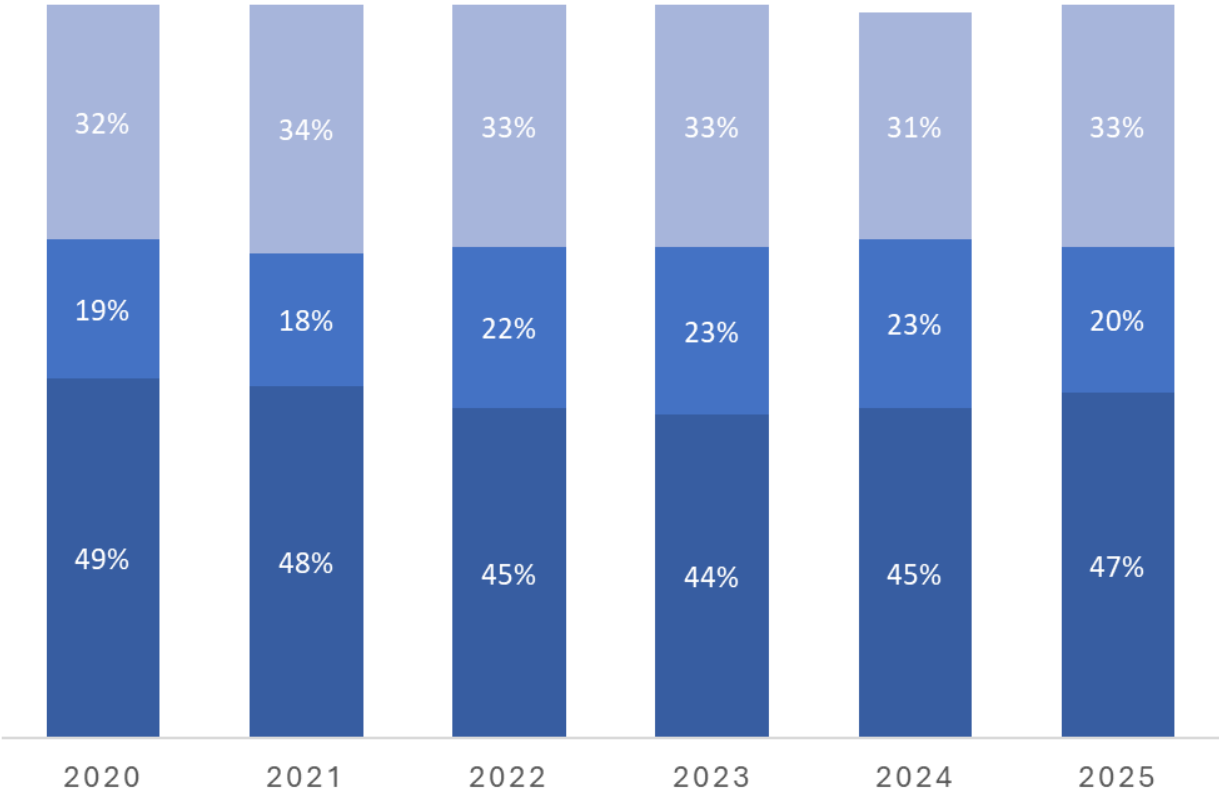
