



2019-20 Award List

For the 2019-20 school year, 51 schools across the five boroughs will receive Arts+Family Engagement grants totaling \$126,219 to enhance schools' existing arts partnerships by creating more opportunities for parent, family, and community engagement around the arts. In addition to the grant amounts listed below, each grantee school receives a \$307 allocation to support DOE staff hours committed toward their grant projects.
