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Condom Availability Program (CAP) Student Notification Letter

Dear Student,

Welcome to the new school year! As a complement to health education, we offer a **Condom Availability Program (CAP)**. This program is available to you all year through our Health Resource Room and participating can help you make responsible decisions about your sexual health.

Visits to the Health Resource Room are confidential. You do not need to give your name, only your student ID number. Here, you can receive:

1. Information about HIV/AIDS, reproductive and sexual health, and other health topics including healthy relationships
2. Free condoms
3. Information about using condoms correctly
4. Referrals to school- and community-based health services that are youth-friendly and LGBTQ+ inclusive

While the Health Resource Room is available to all students, your parent and/or guardian has the right to request that you do not receive condoms through this program. Later this month, we will notify your parents/guardians of what they must include in a letter to the school if they do not want you to receive condoms. Your parent/guardian can decide to “opt you out” or to re-enter you in the program at any time during the school year. This parental opt-out doesn’t apply to students who are 18 years or older, who are or have been married, who are parents, or who are entitled under law to give consent for themselves.

I encourage you to discuss the Condom Availability Program with your parent/guardian. If your parent/guardian chooses to opt you out of receiving condoms, we still encourage you to visit the Health Resource Room for information. Together, we can help stop the spread of HIV and other sexually transmitted infections. Our school community looks forward to helping you learn to make the healthy and informed decisions you need to live a long, productive life. Please check hallway signs for Health Resource Room hours and locations.
