ORGANIZATION OF STUDENT TO TEACHER COURSE LINKAGE

Overview

The Student-Teacher Linkage dataset includes course-level linkages matching students to teachers. The data are stored in comma separated value files (.csv) with three separate files for each school year (grades PK-02, 03-08, and 09-12).

In each file, there are multiple records for students and teachers. Each student and teacher has a unique student identification number, which can be linked across years.

Universe of students/teachers included in dataset

There is one record for every student-teacher linkage during a school year as reported by the Student Transcript and Academic Reporting System (STARS).

Pertinent information about Student-Teacher Linkage data

New York City schools use STARS to create student schedules, enter grades, and print report cards. Schools will begin scheduling courses for a new school year in August. Schools can edit STARS data throughout the year.

Over time guidance on how to use the systems, standardization of course codes, and schools entering information in a timely manner has increased. It is important to note that all data from STARS (MSPA and HSST) is entered by a school staff member and therefore prone to typical human data entry error.
