



Understanding the Mandate Short Description

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Introduction

The Mandate Short Description is a string of abbreviations for each specific detail about the student's IEP mandate. When completing the Encounter Attendance Service Record, the mandates displayed on the Select Mandate pop-up window or from the Mandate Short Description lookup field will match the mandate(s) from the student's current IEP. This allows providers to select the correct mandate to encounter, making it easier to ensure students receive the services as outlined on their IEP.

Note: The images in this guide reflect the mandated service of Speech-Language Therapy. However, all service providers can use this guide.

2	IEP	Type of Conference Document (IEP, IESP, SP, CSP)
3	SP	Service Type (e.g., Speech-Language Therapy)
4	3W	Mandated Frequency (e.g., 3 times per week)
5	30	Mandated Duration (e.g., 30 minutes)
6	1	Mandated Group Size (e.g., Individual or 2 - 8 for Group)
7	EN	Mandated Language of Service (e.g., English)
8	10	10 or 12 Month Service (e.g., 10 month)
9	3	The mandate listed order on the IEP (e.g., Speech-Language
		Therapy is the 3rd mandate)

Mandate Lookup Link

If you provided service for a mandate that is not automatically listed under the Mandate Short Description field, click the **lookup** link to search for the mandate on the Select Mandate pop-up window.

In some circumstances, you may check the following boxes as needed before clicking the *lookup* link:

- To enter a service record for a service type other than your primary role, check the box for Add All Service Types
- To enter a service record for a mandate that is not active based on date of service, check the box for Add Expired/Outside Term Mandates
- To select a mandate which is pending IEP consent or is without IEP consent, check the box for Add Mandates Without/Pending IEP Consent

Note: The Compensatory Services checkbox is used to encounter services from the Compensatory Services section of the IEP, services provided during Sensory Exploration, Education & Discovery (SEED) programming, or services that are not associated with an IEP, IESP, SP or CSP recommendation. It is also selected for services provided pursuant to an impartial hearing order, resolution, or settlement, and Alternate Placement Paraprofessional services.
